Judging Criteria:

Pronunciation (how you pronounce the words)

Fluency (how smoothly you recite the piece)

Intonation (how natural you sound overall)

Presentation (how confident you are, your eye contact, appropriate cultural gestures*)

Memorisation (whether you use notes, how well you remember the script)

*Note: Gestures - less is more! Only use if appropriate to the context of the text/ speech.

You will receive a maximum of five marks for each category, for a total mark out of 25.
